4. The event is open to: All fully elected members of the organising Club, Loughborough Car Club, Lotus 7 Owners Club, Coalville CC, Dukeries MC, Carlton DMC and Mid Derbyshire Motorclub. EDMC Ltd Membership available at signing on, at the standard rate.
5. All competitors and drivers must produce the following: **Relevant club membership card**
6. The programme of the meeting will be:- Signing on 18:30 for 19:00 start. Finish at 21.00 approximately. ENTRY FEE WILL BE £20 PER DRIVER payable on night.
7. Public roads will not be used as link sections. There will be tests on private land. Details of the tests will be issued at signing on.
8. All competitors must comply with the following in order to satisfy the Venue Owners regulations (1) you must stop and change any wheel that suffers a puncture. You must not continue on the rim. (2) Any dropped fluids (oil, petrol, water etc) must be cleaned up immediately. Failure to comply with the above will lead to exclusion.
9. Classes:-

 CLASS 1 – up to 1400cc & non-turbo Deisel engines
 CLASS 2 – 1401cc to 1900cc & turbo Diesel engines
 CLASS 3 – 1901cc and above & with unfair advantage
 (all entry classification subject to final decision of Clerk of Course)
 All vehicles must comply with MSA technical regulations.
