CLUB COMPETITION & CLUBMAN'S CHAMPIONSHIP 2006

The following is the revised 2006 EDMC Club Competition rules & Clubman's Championship rules, which take effect from 1st January 2006

Outline rulings:

1. All claimants **MUST** have been members of Eastwood & District Motor Club at both the time of the competition for which points are being claimed for, and at the time of making the claim.
 2. Where an entry list is published containing club name, that list **MUST** show EDMC or derivative of as the motor club for the claimant. Only events entered as "EDMC" or derivative of shall count and **ONLY** points for the EDMC championship shall be claimed. If any points are claimed for an alternate Motor Club championship, then EDMC points shall be deleted for that event.
 3. **ALL points claims MUST be made within 28 days of the competition**, with the exception of club year end by which all claims must be made by 31st December of that competition year. Claims must be made by post or given in person.
 4. All claims **MUST** be accompanied with a copy of the entry list and printed published results, including any class results. If no class results determinable, no class points shall be awarded.
 5. Points claims may **ONLY** be made via the Club Competition Secretary either in writing to the address as provided by the current Club Comp. Sec.
 6. Only the Club Competition Secretary may receive & update Competition tables (note this excludes any marshalling tables). Copies of this shall be updated at minimum on a monthly basis and be displayed appropriately on the club website, via club magazine "Exhaust" or by direct request from Competition Secretary via S.A.E. this will represent the **ONLY** valid version distributed.

Competition Categories:

1. For the ROAD, STAGE MULTI-USE & STAGE MULTI-VENUE categories, only a championship round of the ANCC, ANEMMC, EMAMC, LCAMC or any association to which EDMC becomes a member club or any event organised/promoted by a member club of any aforementioned regional association which invited member club's are invited shall count to the respective championship categories.

2. In addition to the maximum number of rounds to count as specified for each individual championship category below, a further **MAXIMUM** of 2 events may count to your championship score other than outlined in point 1, with the exception of the **INTERNATIONAL** category which shall be unlimited.
3. A retirement shall score 6 points while an Non-Start or Exclusion shall score no points, irrespective of event type.

ROAD:

Any road, endurance, navigational or historic event of Clubman or National B permit status whereby the event is primarily on the open public highway & specific safety equipment/clothing (i.e. helmets) are not required to be worn. This includes the new "endurance" category. Your "BEST" 9 (Nine) scores shall count.

STAGE – MULTI-USE:

Any event that is depicted in the published regulations as such is contained on one venue including rally sprint and is of National B or below status. Your "BEST" 9 (Nine) scores shall count.

STAGE – MULTI-VENUE:

Any event that is depicted in the published regulations as such, comprises route on more than one venue and includes sections of the open public highway and is National B or below status. Your "BEST" 6 (Six) scores shall count.

INTERNATIONAL:

International permit event that does not fit the above Road or Stage criteria. These events do **NOT** need to be a round within the boundaries of the aforementioned regional associations and is **NOT** limited in number for claims to qualify for this championship.

Point's breakdown for championship categories:

The following is a breakdown of the points applied to ALL championship categories, irrespective of event type, size, class structure or number of classes:

Overall event position

– Irrespective of number of EDMC starters/finishers:

Event class position – STAGE ONLY

– irrespective of number of EDMC competitors in specified class:

OVERALL POSITION IN CLASS:	POINTS AWARDED:
Highest EDMC within any class	10
2 nd Highest EDMC within any class	9
3 rd Highest EDMC within any class	8
4 th Highest EDMC within any class	7
5 th Highest EDMC within any class	6
6 th Highest EDMC to 10 th in any class	5 ... down to 1

- ? Class position will be determined as to highest placed EDMC contender within their class scoring maximum points.
- ? Class structure will be determined by published class structure in event regulations/results
- ? If tie as best placed in any class, then points shall be awarded at higher O/A.
- ? Any contender can score points as different class each event as depicted by entry list/results for each event.

Example:

Contender A finishes 3rd O/A in event, 2nd in class - 20 O/A points + 10 CLASS points

Contender B finishes 7th O/A in event, 6th in class - 17 O/A points + 8 CLASS points

Contender C finishes 24th O/A in event, 4th in class - 15 O/A points + 9 CLASS points

This will be particularly notable in Multi-Use & Multi-Venue stage rallies with regard to offering class points based upon performance against competitors in similarly powered machinery.

EDMC CLUBMAN'S CHAMPIONSHIP:

The following championship is subject to only the basic rules as follows:

1. All points awarded shall be taken from the published Competition & Marshaling tables as issued by the respective Club Competition Secretary & Club Chief Marshal/s.
2. Points do NOT need to be claimed for by club members.
3. Tables & categories are subject to change dependent upon events organised/promoted by/for EDMC.
4. ALL EDMC event organisers MUST forward a copy of appropriate names to the Club Competition secretary for calculation of points. This includes competitor names, results & marshal/organising team names.
5. If EDMC promotes an event outside those specified, category will be added.
