“Fun in the Sun” Gymkhana

Supplementary Regulations

Introduction:

Eastwood & District Motor Club will run a fun Sunday Gymkhana event that will take place using a grass field at Drum Hill, Derbyshire. The field is reported as being suitable for ordinary cars.

It will consist of a series of tests involving manoeuvring around a number of cones together with an activity for a passenger to perform during the test, either as part of navigation, or while the car is stationary. The overall results are calculated by summing penalties for each type of test, meaning that it is not always the driver with the best tyres/the most power who wins the event.

Entry is per combined driver/passenger. A passenger can also enter separately as a driver, with another person as a passenger. A car can be used by multiple entrants.

The event should be suitable for all the family to join in, either as drivers or passengers, however drivers must be in possession of a valid UK driving licence. Children are welcome but must be supervised at all times for their own safety.

Club membership to enable non-club members to compete will be required at entry stage.

To make the event work participants might need to take part in observing and/or setting up the tests, thus allowing everyone who wants to, the chance to compete.

1. Announcements:

Eastwood and District Motor Club will organise a Gymkhana event on 13th September 2026 in a field at Drum Hill, Morley Lane, Little Eaton, Derby, Derbyshire, DE21 5AH (MR128/374 418) What 3 Words [///report.dizzy.tame](https://www.what3words.com/report.dizzy.tame).

2. Jurisdiction:

The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK, National Competition Rules 2026, these Supplementary Regulations and any instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

3. Authorisations:

Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption Permit No. (TBC) applies.

4. Eligibility:

This event is open to all fully elected members of Eastwood & District Motor Club, Mid Derbyshire Motor Club, Matlock Motor Club, Loughborough Car Club, Owen CC and Rolls-Royce Employees Motor Club. Club membership cards (for drivers) must be produced at Signing On. No Competition Licence is required for this event

5. Vehicle Technical Regulations:

The vehicle must be road legal and able to be driven to the event and have standard road tyres (i.e. not Knobbles/forest tyres) and be fitted with a suitable silencer. There are no other restrictions.

6. Programme

The programme of the event will be:

Signing on and setting up	10.30am to 11.00am
Briefing	11.15am
First test start	11.30am
Finish	16.00pm (approximately)

The organisers reserve the right to truncate the event dependent on weather and/or field conditions on the day, the number of participants and time taken to complete each test.

7. Route

Non scaled plans of the tests will be given out at signing on. Once the tests are set up all competitors will be given the opportunity to walk the course prior to starting.

8. Equipment

1 Driver and 1 passenger in the front seat/s per car at a time. Any rear seat passenger/s MUST sign on at the start of the event and be sat in the correct seat position.

9. Classes

The event will consist of one class

10. Awards

1st Driver/Passenger combination

11. Entries

Cost will be £5 per driver/passenger combination.

The cost includes 1 x burger for all car occupants, unless the entrant otherwise specifies on the entry form.

The maximum entry for the event is 30 Cars (Driver/Passenger combination) the minimum is 5. Should the minimum not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the event and entry fees paid will be refunded in full.

13. Results

Results will be declared on the day as soon as possible following completing of the last agreed test.

No Test will be determined solely by the speed of the competing vehicle or by the skill of the driver in controlling the vehicle – and in which when timed tests will equal in number there will be at least an equal number of untimed tests. No test will be timed to less than five seconds. Should a tie remain, the tie decider will be advised on the day.

14. Penalties

The penalties will be advised in the final instructions, issued on the day

15. Other information

Participants are advised to bring clothing and footwear suitable for standing out in a field for the day. Camping Chairs/picnic blankets are also suggested.

The organisers will be providing some food and drink on the day, but participants should bring their own food and drinks to meet any special dietary needs.

The club will provide a toilet facility suitable for all participants.

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead/under control at all times. Dog mess must be cleared up immediately and removed from site by the owner at the end of the day. Please also take all your other rubbish with you when leaving – thank you!
