## Eastwood & District Motor Club Competition Championship Rules and Regulations 2024

### General Rules for all championships:

- Open to all EDMC members
- Competition secretary's decision is final
- All events to count (no min or max)
- All points to be claimed to the EDMC Competition secretary by email
- Points claims to include – entry list (showing competitor has entered as EDMC member) and the final results.
- All competitors to promote EDMC by displaying the red 'E' badge on the car – send a photo with points claim or post on EDMC social media pages
- 5 bonus points for additional promotion of the club through social media? Example post your exploits on EDMC Facebook page and get an extra 5 points
- Claim points within 6 weeks of results being made final
- Events organised by EDMC will automatically award points to competitors, so no need to claim.
- All Championships to end 20th December (and claims after until 31<sup>st</sup> December will be carried over into next years tables)
- Ties will be settled by – competitor with highest score from the first (and same) event that the tied competitors competed on will come first. If the tied competitors have never competed on the same event – the earliest event competed on will come first.
- Awards
  - if 2 or less competitors in championship – only award 1<sup>st</sup> place
  - if 3 or more competitors in championship – award 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place
  - if 5 or more competitors in championship – award 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place
- Points Breakdown
  - Competitors final position in their class, plus the total number of finishers in their class.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> in class = 50 points, 10<sup>th</sup> in class = 41 points, 41<sup>st</sup> in class = 10 points
  - Plus 10 points for 10 class finishers, 1 point for only finisher in class
    - Example 1<sup>st</sup> in class (50 points), 5 class finishers = 55 points
    - Example 3<sup>rd</sup> in class (48 points), 10 class finishers = 58 points
    - Example 11<sup>th</sup> in class (40 points), 15 class finishers = 55 points
  - Retirements will be awarded 10 points
  - Non-starters or exclusions will get no points
