



“Park Life” Scenic Tour – Final Instructions

Sunday 8th June 2025

Thank you for entering the Eastwood and District Motor Club Scenic Tour. We hope you have an enjoyable day and the route takes you through some pleasant countryside.

Cars will leave the start at minute intervals in the order shown on the attached entry list. Please arrive at the start 2 minutes before your due start time. There is no competitive element to this event, the timing is simply to aid traffic flow and avoid congestion.

Behaviour

Please drive at a leisurely pace with consideration for other road users as you are likely to encounter cyclists, horses, pedestrians and the odd pot hole on the lanes you will be travelling along.

Please follow any instructions given by officials as they are there to help make the event run smoothly. Please try not to bunch up. If you approach a village in a convoy, wait, and go through slowly and individually or at most in batches of five to give the locals a chance.

Route

The route will be defined by “tulip” diagrams and specified mileages. The ball represents the approach to the junction and arrow the direction of leaving. Remember that not all junctions are shown. A tulip junction diagram will only be shown if the intended route deviates from the road on which you are travelling. It is therefore important to use the total or inter mileages to ensure that you are at the correct junction.

Adjacent to each tulip diagram is a Route Information Box, which will contain signpost directions, place names, cautions and any other necessary information. Variations in the calibration of car mileage recorders may mean that junctions may not occur exactly as written in the road book. It is therefore important to refer to the Route Information Box for an exact description of the junction’s features and signpost directions.

Timings

Due to the nature of the event, other than the time of the pre-event formalities at the start, all other timings are simply a guide to assist you in planning your day:

- 08:50 Ruddington Transport Heritage Centre gates open
- 09:00 Documentation – in the cafe
- 09:00 Breakfast – in the cafe
- 09:50 Driver/Navigator briefing
- 10:00 First car starts
- 12:20 Halfway halt 1st car. Please look for the EDMC flag and banner. 1 hour allowed for lunch, £2.00 will be supplied with your documents to cover 1 hour parking. Refreshments may be available in the car park, please bring your own picnic.
- 13:00 First car should leave the halfway halt.
- 14:35 Afternoon tea stop 1st car
- 16:00 First car due at the finish
- 16:30 Hot meal service begins
- 17:00 Last car should be at the finish

Petrol

The nearest fuel stations to the start are Esso Ruddington NG11 6LJ (ESSO - Nectar cards can be used) and Morrisons NG2 6PS, both open at 08:00. We suggest you arrive at the start with at least enough fuel for 130 miles.

We hope you have a great day. Please remember this is not a competition or a race – enjoy the scenery and places of interest, and we look forward to seeing you at the finish.
