Safeguarding is everybody's responsibility.

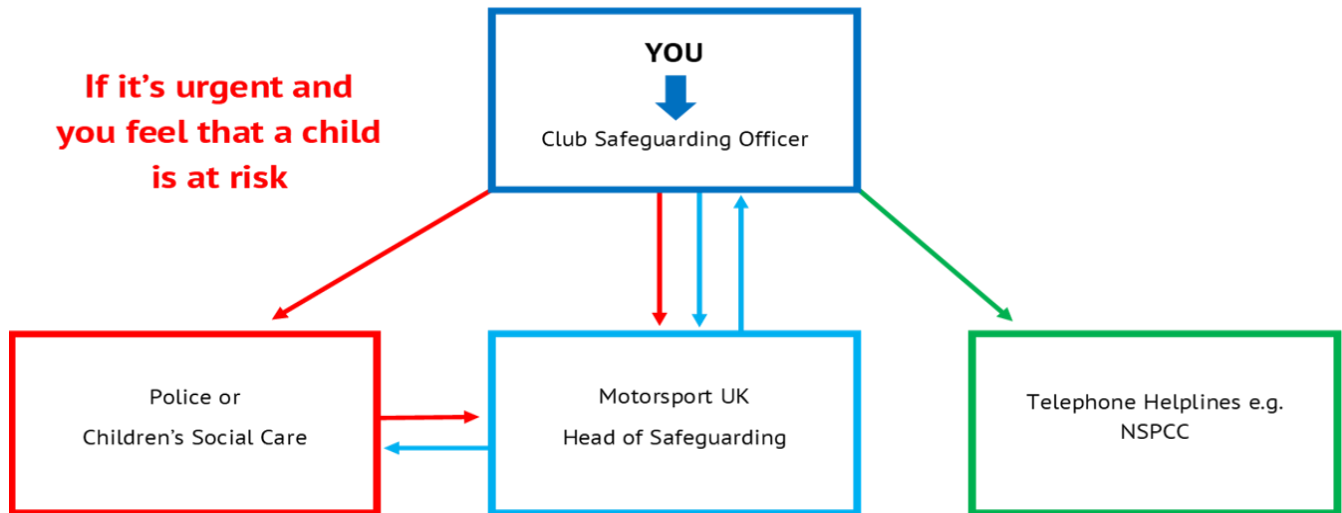
Please report all safeguarding or welfare concerns to The Eastwood & District Motor Club Safeguarding Officer (CSO).

Concerns that an individual maybe at risk of immediate harm **must** be reported to the Police and then to Motorsport UK Safeguarding team so that they can assist the Police as appropriate.
