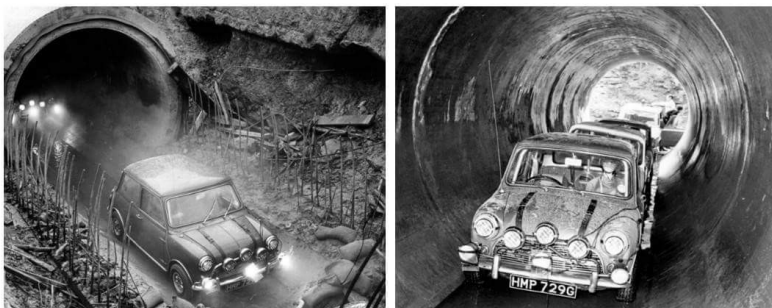
## What is happening? And Where?

## 4. **The Treasurer Report, Charles Knifton reported:-**

Good evening. Hopefully you have all had chance to read your Annual Report – you will see that overall we made a loss of £2,917.

This can be contributed to a variety of things – subsidising Club Members via Awards Night evening and buffets (£537), via club tabards (£288) and club clothing discounts (£283).

We agreed to digitize all our known paper copies of Club Exhaust Magazines for posterity and history of the club (£1440) – and overall Competition Income reduced to a small £1k loss after events costs, buying stage equipment and supporting the Clubsport events.

But I have good and comforting news in that our Reserves are still well in hand and remain at the same levels as before and as such, the Club remains financially extremely secure and still able to support both motorsport and members with suitable and welcome discounts/subsidies.

If you have any ideas on how to spend any of the clubs money on equipment or promotion to benefit the club please let the Committee know; or better still join the Committee.

I would like to thank Sue Knifton and Malcolm Young for their continued assistance and if anyone would like the position of Treasurer I am willing to stand down.
