 The Minutes of the previous Meeting (Tuesday 4th October 2016) were circulated and taken as read Proposed Simon Naylor

4. The Treasurer Report, Charles Knifton reported:-

Good evening. Hopefully you have all had chance to read your Annual Report – you will see that overall we made a loss of $\pounds 2,917$.

This can be contributed to a variety of things – subsidising Club Members via Awards Night evening and buffets (\pounds 537), via club tabards (\pounds 288) and club clothing discounts (\pounds 283).

We agreed to digitize all our known paper copies of Club Exhaust Magazines for posterity and history of the club (\pounds 1440) – and overall Competition Income reduced to a small \pounds 1k loss after events costs, buying stage equipment and supporting the Clubsport events.

But I have good and comforting news in that our Reserves are still well in hand and remain at the same levels as before and as such, the Club remains financially extremely secure and still able to support both motorsport and members with suitable and welcome discounts/subsidies.

If you have any ideas on how to spend any of the clubs money on equipment or promotion to benefit the club please let the Committee know; or better still join the Committee.

I would like to thank Sue Knifton and Malcolm Young for their continued assistance and if anyone would like the position of Treasurer I am willing to stand down.

Ladies and Gentlemen Eastwood Motor Club is still in good shape despite the operating loss last year as reported by our treasurer due to the loss on our event at Mallory Park and investment in new club cones for our events and the digital archive of old club mags.

Our club sport events last year included grass Autotest and the AutoSOLO at Fulbeck Kart track which were well supported. Unfortunately due the weather we lost our PCT and lack of support for the Scatter and 12 Car rallies was disappointing.

Our stage rallies are continuing to run in 3 of our local championships ANCC, EMAMC, and ANEMMC with several crews registered.

The awards night is still proving popular in its present format and thanks to Sandra and Joy for all their hard work for the catering.

Finally my thanks to all the organisers who have devoted their time and effort in all our events over the past year.
