The Eastwood & District Motor Club Limited (EDMC) has pleasure in extending an invitation to join us for our 2nd Scenic Tour on Sunday 8th June 2025.

Following the very successful Scenic Tour run last year in memory of Rick Hickman and Paul Davis, we received some wonderful praise and feedback from those who took part – and with the same organising team as before, we do hope that you will return once more for this Scenic Tour.

The start and finish will be at the Nottingham Transport Heritage Centre at Ruddington, Nottingham - a start/finish venue which (if you have never visited before) may surprise you with what can be found there! The route will consist of approximately 110 miles and includes some lovely quiet and picture-perfect lanes (that you may never have driven before!) and some legendary road rally lanes on OS Maps 128 / 129 / 140. You will receive a quality road book using Tulips and written instructions which will provide information about the route, and a vehicle tour plate.

Breakfast will be served as a hot breakfast roll and a hot drink at the start. A halfway halt will be designated in the roadbook, allowing participants to enjoy a picnic and natter with other participants. An additional stop is included in the afternoon section of the event for a comfort break and afternoon tea for those that require it – this is a very interesting place to have a quick look around as well! Upon completion of the tour, an optional hot meal will be available at the finish.

At the end of the tour, why not have a wander around the transport museum, this is included in your entry fee. You will have time to view the exhibits and chat about your day and memories with other participants.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Announcement

a) The Eastwood & District Motor Club Limited (EDMC) will organise a Scenic Tour/ Touring Assembly (per MSUK NCR Chap1 App.1), on Sunday 8th June 2025. Starting and finishing at The Nottingham Transport Heritage Centre, Ruddington Fields Business Park, Ruddington, Nottingham, NG11 6JS.

2. Organisation of the Event

a) The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

b) Motorsport UK Touring Assembly Certificate of Exemption No. 202735 has been issued for this touring assembly.

3. Eligibility

 a) The event is open to fully elected members of EDMC, members of Invited Clubs Carlton & DMC, Loughborough CC, Mid Derbyshire MC, Matlock MC, Dukeries MC, Coalville Car Club, Mercia MSC, Rolls-Royce employees Motor Club, Porsche Club Great Britain and MG Owners Club. We can invite more Motor Clubs – just let us know.

Members of the public may also participate (per MSUK NCR Chap7 App.7 Art.1.2)

b) All drivers must produce a valid driving licence for the vehicle being driven at signing-on. All drivers must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event and the entry form contains a declaration to this effect that the driver must sign.

c) Only drivers nominated on the entry form are permitted to drive.

d) This touring assembly has no competitive element – no competition licences are required.

e) Only passengers who have been included and paid for on the Entry Form may be carried up to the maximum number for which proper seating is provided in the vehicle entered.

f) Entrants will be provided with an event plate which must be displayed in a prominent position at the front of the car. No competition numbers may be displayed.

4. Entries

a) All entries must be sent to the Entries Secretary for the event - Stephen Gozzard, (07818 442531) no calls after 21:00hrs please or via the email at eastwooddmc.events@gmail.com

b) The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes finally on Sunday 25th May 2025.

c) The entry fee will be \pounds 40.00. The entry fee will include a hot drink and a hot breakfast roll per vehicle for a crew of two (driver and navigator). Additional breakfasts for passengers are available at \pounds 5.50 each.

A two course meal may also be booked (in advance only) at a cost of \pounds 14.00 per person. This MUST be booked in advance with your entry please – no additional orders can be made on the day.

The meal will be a Sunday Roast (choice of meats or vegetarian) - followed by a choice of dessert.

d) All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Please use Bank Transfer payment via internet banking, the Clubs details to use are:

Payment by cheque is possible and should be made payable to "Eastwood & District Motor Club" and sent to the Entries Secretary at: 5 Kingsclere Avenue, Oakwood, Derby, DE21 2QH.

Entries will not be accepted by telephone.

e) All entry fees are payable in advance but may be refunded if the event is cancelled or the entry is withdrawn in writing prior to the closing date. Refunds, if granted, will be at the sole discretion of EDMC taking into account any expenses already incurred.

f) The entry fee includes:

- Detailed final instructions
- A fully detailed Road Book
- An event Rally Plate
- Breakfast for driver and navigator at the start.

g) The maximum number of entries is 50 and the minimum 15. Should the maximum number be exceeded the entry list will be determined by the date the entry was

received. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event should the minimum number not be achieved by the closing date for entries. In these circumstances the entry fee would be returned.

h) EDMC as the event organiser, reserves the right to refuse an entry and is not bound to give reasons for so doing.

i) Acknowledgement of entries will be sent by email where possible or by post. Final instructions and the provisional entry list will be sent to the driver either by email or post during the week prior to the event.

5. Programme

Due to the nature of the event, other than the time of the pre-event formalities at the start, all other timings are simply a guide to assist you in planning your day:

- 09:00 Documentation
- 09:15 Breakfast
- 09:50 Driver/Navigator briefing
- 10:00 First car starts
- 12:20 Halfway halt 1st car (please bring your own picnic)
- 14:35 Afternoon tea stop 1st car
- 16.00 First car due at finish
- 16.30 Hot meal service begins

6. Insurance

a) Drivers must have valid insurance in accordance with the Road Traffic Act and relevant laws applicable in the UK and will be required to sign a declaration that they are covered by such insurance.

b) All participants in the event must sign an indemnity required under the terms of the policy held by the organisers relevant to the event.

7. Documentation and Vehicle check

a) In the week before the event, entrants will receive the Final Instructions and any other relevant documents via email.

b) Vehicle examination may be carried out at the start and may also be undertaken at any subsequent location on the event.

c) The following current and valid documents will be required as documentation:

• Driving Licence

d) Any vehicle found to be in an un-road worthy condition will not be allowed to start/continue.

e) All entrants are required to "Sign On" at documentation.

f) At the start, documentation detailing the route and any "check" will be issued. As this is not a competition entrants may choose to follow the suggested route or determine their own should the need arise.

8. The Start

a) The event will start from The Nottingham Transport Heritage Centre, Ruddington Fields Business Park, Ruddington, Nottingham, NG11 6JS.

b) The starting order will be decided at the organiser's discretion.

c) Cars will leave the start at intervals of one minute.

d) Individual start times will be included with the Final Instructions.

9. Route

a) The suggested route will be approximately 110 miles on sealed surface public roads of various classes.

b) A full Tulip Road Book will be provided. The mileages in the Road Book have been set using the "Rally Trip Meter" app trip meter. The Road Book will also contain written instructions and sundry information.

c) An overall time allowance will be given for the route.

d) The suggested route will follow some sections of classic routes used by EDMC road events in the past and pass by/through a number of the East Midlands notable parks. Hopefully this will provide a fun, scenic drive to enjoy our wonderful countryside.

e) A "Halfway Halt" has been planned to allow time (1hr) for your own picnic lunch, where Toilets will be available. A further Afternoon Tea Halt is planned to allow time for a cuppa and comfort break – and a worthwhile look around!

f) The start, halfway and afternoon tea halt/s and finish will be Check Points – purely to ensure timely departs and arrivals from/to the respective venues.

g) Fuel will be available at various points along the route and near the start/finish venue.

10. The Finish

a) The finish will be back at the Nottingham Transport Heritage Centre, Ruddington Fields Business Park, Ruddington, Nottingham, NG11 6JS.

b) Entrants will be required to hand in their signed damage declaration sheet.

11. Jurisdiction

The Clerk of Course for the event have absolute discretion in the interpretation and application of the event Regulations.
